Bylaws & Policies

5451 - STUDENT RECOGNITION

The Board of Education values excellence and wishes to inculcate in students the desire to do their best in all things. It shall be the policy of this Board, therefore, to recognize outstanding accomplishment in curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular areas.

Schools may only use funds for student recognition programs generated through a fund-raising or donation-soliciting activity. Prior to commencing the activity, the school shall:

- A. publicize the activity as intended for this purpose, and;
- B. designate for this purpose the funds generated.

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop and implement a plan for recognition of outstanding student achievement based on well-defined, consistent criteria and standards.
