The WVDE Selection Criteria: Application Review Information

1. Quality of Proposal (55 points available).

The WVDE will consider the quality of the proposal based on description, verified need based on data and the proposed plan per the selected priority.

- 25 Points The extent to which the proposed project will expand access to remote learning options, increase social/emotional well-being and ultimately lead to improvements in student outcomes.
- 20 Points The extent to which the proposed project reflects up-to-date knowledge from research and effective practice.
- 20 Points The extent to which the plan includes members of all groups that have traditionally been under-represented based on race, color, national origin, gender, age, or disability.

2. Quality of the Adequacy of Resources (45 points available).

The WVDE considers the quality of the adequacy of resources.

- **15 Points -** The extent to which the proposed use of funds will adequately support the proposed priority.
- **15 Points** The extent to which the costs are reasonable in relation to the proposed plan.
- **15 Points -** The extent to which the costs are reasonable in relation to the anticipated number of students to be served, and the anticipated benefits.
