

Administrative Guidelines 223.iii – Weighted Courses

1. For the purposes of computing a student’s grade point average, all courses not listed in these guidelines shall be considered “not weighted.”
2. The following courses shall be considered “weighted:”

AP Calculus	AP Environmental Science
AP English Language	AP Government and Politics
AP English Literature	AP United States History
3. Any course offered as dual-credit with an institution of higher education and that provides an opportunity for the student to earn college credit shall be considered “weighted,” so long as the student earns such credit. Should the student not earn college credit as a result of his/her enrollment in such a course, the course shall be considered “not weighted” for that student.
4. Beginning with the 2019-20 school year and thereafter, any section of a course offered as an “honors” section shall be considered “weighted.”
5. Beginning with the 2019-20 school year and thereafter, the final ~~Each~~ course taken to complete a career and technical education pathway shall be considered “weighted” if and only if the student completes such pathway.
6. These guidelines shall be enforced beginning with the 9th-grade cohort of 2018-19.
