


- 314 Families

# WHICH SCHOOL DOES YOUR CHILD OR CHILDREN ATTEND?


- GEMS -20.4% response rate

- County-27% response rate




# IS YOUR CHILD AN IN-PERSON LEARNER, DISTANCE LEARNER, OR VIRTUAL LEARNER?



# WHAT GRADE IS YOUR CHILD OR CHILDREN IN CURRENTLY?




# WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING HAVE YOU USED TO FIND INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL?




# HOW OFTEN DO YOU READ ALOUD TO YOUR CHILD?

- 36% Read aloud to their child Monthly, Yearly, or Never.
- High School Responses total 36% of responses which may account for the 36% that read aloud to their child monthly or less.




# WHEN YOU DO READ ALOUD WITH YOUR CHILD, HOW LONG DO YOU SPEND ON AVERAGE?

- 97% of the families that reported reading daily to their children also report discussing student grades on a daily basis.
- 94% of the families that reported reading daily to their children also report that they review their student's homework.




# HOW OFTEN DO YOU DISCUSS ASSIGNMENTS WITH YOUR CHILD?




# HOW OFTEN DO YOU ASSIST WITH READING ASSIGNMENTS?


- 77% of the families have reported assisting with reading assignments on a daily or as needed basis.

# HOW OFTEN DO YOU ASSIST WITH MATH ASSIGNMENTS?




76% of the families have reported assisting with math assignments on a daily or as needed basis.






# HOW OFTEN DO YOU DISCUSS GRADES?




# HOW OFTEN DO YOU TALK TO OR EMAIL YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER?



# HOW OFTEN DO YOU RECEIVE UPDATES FROM YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER?



# THE SCHOOL IS A PARENT FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENT.
